This week's beautiful weather is a reminder that we are now moving out of the winter period of our Sun Protection Policy. Sun hats and sunscreen are needed anytime the UV level is 3 or above. During August, this is usually in the middle part of the day, but the times and levels get longer and higher each week as we head closer to summer.

All children and educators are required to wear appropriate sun safe clothing when outside. Children wearing tops and dresses without sleeves will need to put on a t-shirt or longer sleeved top before going outside. All children and educators are required to wear hats that protect their face, neck and ears, eg: legionnaire, broad brimmed or bucket hats. **Please ensure you have a sun hat packed for your child.**

A reminder that Centre Photos will be held on Tuesday, the 10th of September and Thursday, the 12th of September. Preschool families will find yellow payment envelopes in their pockets and childcare families can collect an envelope from the Office.
